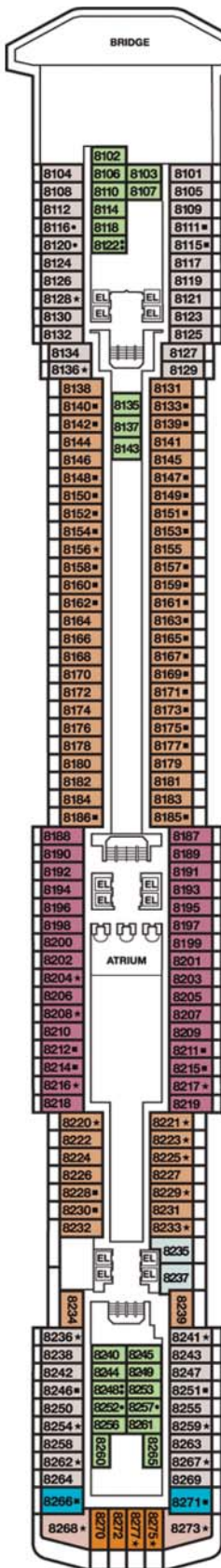
Carnival Miracle Deck Plan

Accommodation Symbol Legend

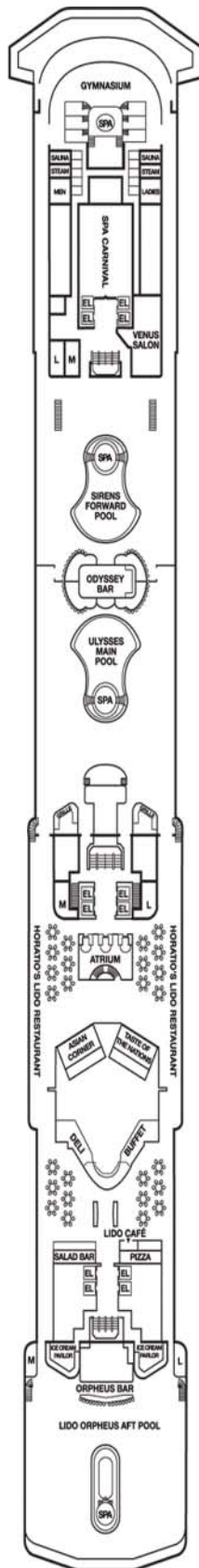

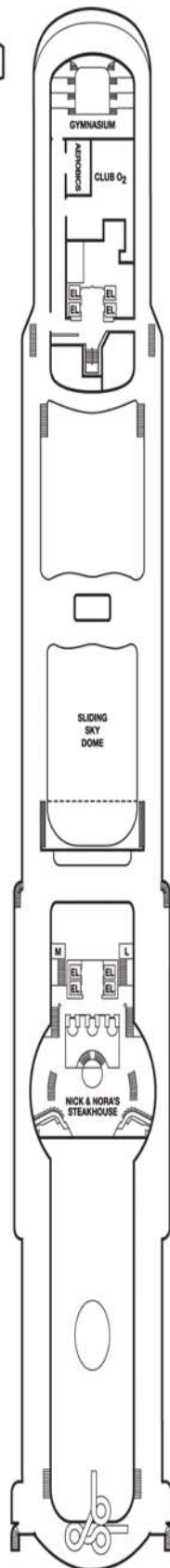

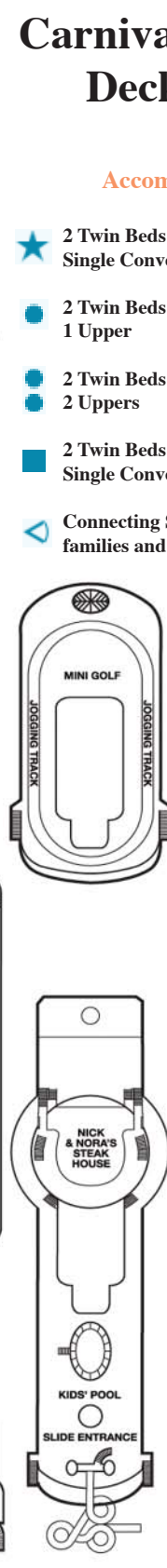

The Carnival Miracle has an overall length of 292.5m, a 38.8m maximum breadth over the bridge wings (32.2m at water level) and a 7.8m draught. In total, there are 1,062 passenger staterooms, of which 849 (80%) face outside and 750 (70%) have balconies.

GOOD-TO KNOW INFO

FUNPASS Advance Registration - U.S. Border Security Act

Carnival is required to provide the Department of Homeland Security with specific guest information and a final departure manifest. To comply, you must register in advance of your cruise by going to carnival.com/mycruise and clicking on the FUNPASS icon. You will need your Carnival booking number, ship and sail date to access your record. Bare Necessities will provide you with this booking number approximately 30 days prior to departure. Once you complete the required fields, you will obtain a FUNPASS that will allow you to “fast track” through a documentation verification process at embarkation.

Travel Documents

All passengers **MUST** travel with a passport valid for at least 6 months beyond completion of travel. Once you receive your booking number, you will be able to print your boarding pass, reserve shore excursions, refer to Frequently Asked Questions, make specialty dining reservations, spa appointments, and more. Cancellations and Refunds

If a cancellation occurs, the following charges will be assessed:

Cancellations received prior to October 15, 2010 will receive a full refund less \$100 per person. After October 15, 2010 payments are non-refundable. Trip insurance is highly recommended. (See our website for more information)

Decorum and Attire Aboard

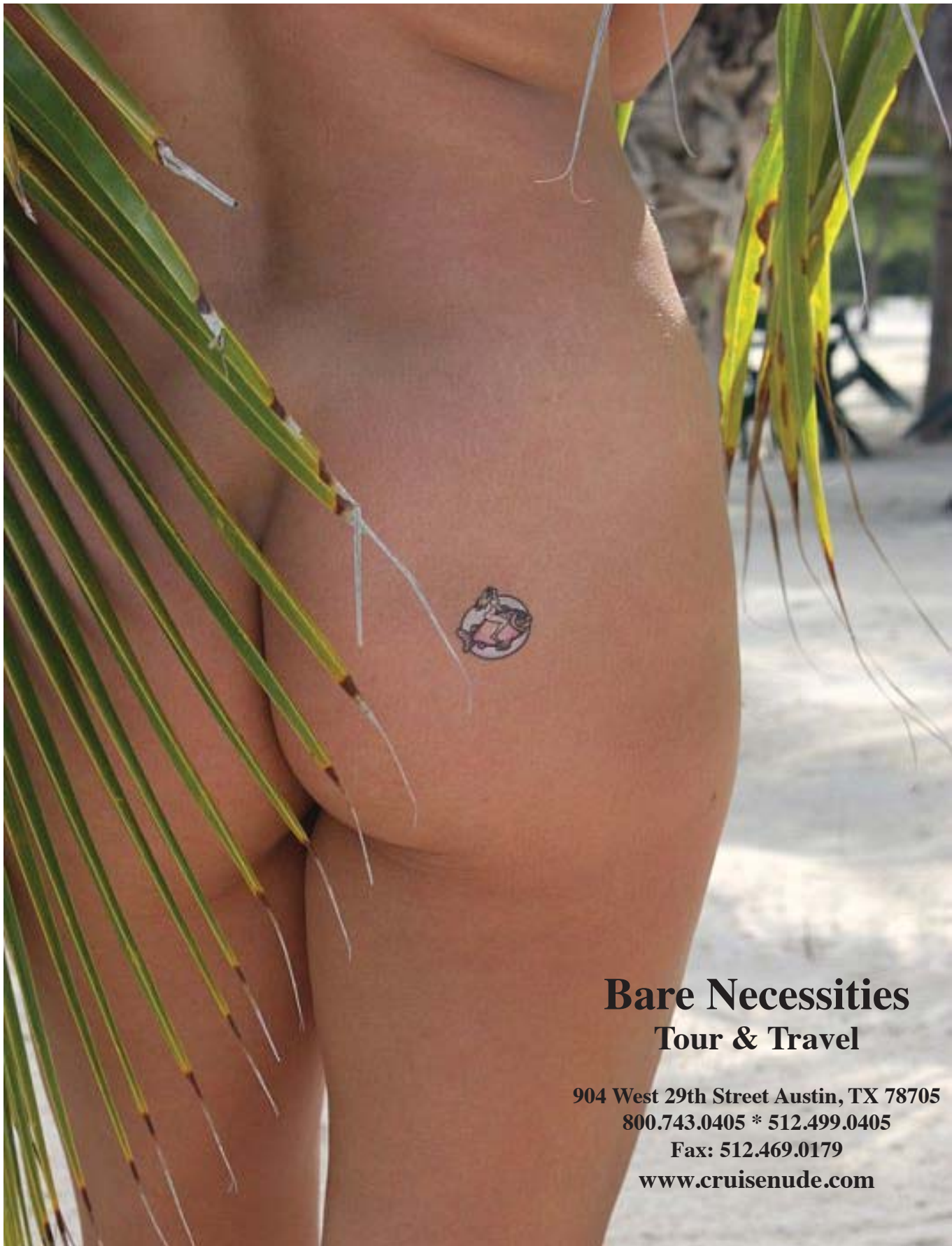
